Our field is the best in the region for EDF jets and smaller planes, which is the bulk of our activity. With a few hours of work, we can keep it that way. For any KCRC'er that isn't a regular SPA'er, I'm offering a reduced \$10 (from \$30) entry fee into the Basic or Sportsman class.
